CGI's new SGD system is entering the market with more economical pricing, industry leading design loads up to +120/-170 PSF, panel sizes up to 5'x10', and minimal covers, snaps and extra parts. With a simple frame assembly and a single row of fasteners, customers are expected to benefit from significant installation cost savings.



The Series 560 Sliding Glass Door maintains similar sightlines to the CGI 450 French Doors and includes standard features not found in competitive products including: a Maximum Security S/S deadbolt lock, cast S/S keeper and tandem S/S rollers with precision bearings. Standard hardware finishes are Satin Nickel PVD and Dark Bronze (simulating Oil Rubbed Bronze). Large and small missile testing has been completed.

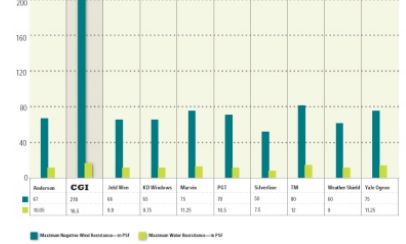
